## Home School Partnership

**The Parent / Carer, I / we will:**

- See that my son/daughter goes to school regularly and arrives on time.
- Telephone/email the school if my son/daughter is absent or late and provide notes or comments in their pupil planner.
- Ensure that my son/daughter has the correct uniform and equipment.
- Support the school's policies and guidelines for behaviour, including bullying (physical and verbal) both in and out of school.
- Make the school aware of any concerns or problems that might affect my son/daughter's work or behaviour.
- Support my son/daughter in completing his/her homework.
- Support my son/daughter's progress by attending Parents' Evenings.

**The school will:**

- Care for your son/daughter's safety and welfare.
- Encourage your son/daughter's highest standards of work.
- Provide a balanced curriculum that meets the needs of your son/daughter.
- Keep you informed on a regular basis about your son/daughter's progress.
- Teach the value of being a member of the community and respecting others.
- Achieve high standards of behaviour by building good relationships.
- Be open and welcoming whenever you come into school.
- Offer opportunities for you to become involved in the daily life of the school.

**The Student will:**

- Attend school regularly and on time.
- Follow the school Code of Conduct (Be Ready, Be Kind, Be Safe).
- Bring all the equipment I need each day.
- Wear the school uniform and be tidy in appearance.
- Do all classwork and home-learning as well as I can.
- Help keep the school free of litter and graffiti.
- I shall, under no circumstances, bully (physically or verbally) other students.

## ICT Acceptable Use Agreement

ICT including the internet, learning platforms, email and mobile technologies has become an important part of learning in our school. We expect all pupils to be safe and responsible when using any ICT. It is essential that pupils are aware of eSafety and know how to stay safe when using any ICT.

- I, the Student, will be responsible for my behaviour when using the school's computers and other technologies, including the internet, email, digital video, my mobile phone or any other devices and will only access resources related to my work and what I am learning.
- I will not download or install software on school technologies.
- I will only log on to the school network/ learning platform with my own user name and password.
- I will change my passwords regularly and I will not reveal them to anyone.
- I will only use my own school email address in school.
- I will make sure that all ICT communications with pupils, teachers or others is responsible and sensible.
- I will not deliberately browse, download, upload or forward material that could be considered offensive or illegal. If I come across any such material I will report it immediately to my teacher.
- I will not give out any personal information such as name, phone number or address. I will not arrange to meet someone unless this is part of a school project approved by my teacher.

- Video or pictures will only be taken, stored and used for purposes in line with school policy and not be distributed outside the school network without permission.
- I will ensure that my online activity, both in school and outside school, will not cause the staff, pupils or others distress or bring the school into disrepute.
- I will support the school approach to online safety and not deliberately upload, use or store any images, video, sounds or text that could upset or offend any member of the school community.
- I will respect the privacy and ownership of others' work on-line at all times.
- I will not attempt to bypass the internet filtering system or attempt to tamper with any hardware or settings.
- I understand that all my use of the internet and other related technologies can be monitored and logged and can be made available to my teachers.
- I understand that these rules are designed to keep me safe and that if they are not followed, school sanctions will be applied.
- I will not attempt to bypass the school's ICT security systems, the internet filtering system or attempt to tamper with any hardware or settings.

## Image Consent

Occasionally we will take photographs of your children whilst at school. The images that we take may be used in our School Prospectus or in other printed publications that we produce, in displays and on our website. We may also make video or webcam recordings for school-to-school conferences, monitoring or other educational use. Images may also be sent to the news media, or our school may be visited by the media who will take their own photographs or film footage. Students will often appear in these images which may be used on televised news programmes or on their websites. When we submit photographs and information to the media, we have no control on when, where, if or how they will be used.

To comply with the Data Protection Act, we need your permission before we can photograph or make any recordings of your child.

### Conditions of Use

- This form is valid for the period of time your child attends The John Warner School. Please write to the school if you wish to withdraw your consent at any time.
- The images that we take will be of activities that show the school and children in a positive light.
- Embarrassing or distressing images will not be used. The images will not be associated with negative or sensitive issues.
- We may use group or class photographs or footage with very general labels, e.g. Science Lesson.
- We will only use images of students who are suitably dressed.
- We will make every effort to ensure that we do not allow images to be taken of any students for whom we do not have permission or who are 'at risk' or disallowed from having their photographs taken for legal or social reasons.
- We will take all reasonable measures to ensure the images are used solely for the purposes for which they are intended. However, we cannot guarantee this and take no responsibility for the way images are used by other websites or publishers or for any consequences arising from publication.
