Dear Parent(s)/Carer(s)

I am writing to you to outline the support and provision we are continuing to put in place in order to prepare our Year 11 students for their GCSE examinations in the summer.

Firstly, I would like to commend the year 11's on their focus and their approach to school this half term. In the run up to the mock examinations we have been very impressed with their excellent attitudes towards their studies, especially during these uncertain times. The two week mock examination period begins on **Monday 23rd November**. We will also be running a further mock examination period in March.

### Recovery Timetable

As you are aware, we have had a recovery timetable in place since the start of term to support students in response to their missed time in school during lockdown. These sessions, which run before and after school have been well attended. They will continue to run once the mock examination period is over and I have included the timetable so that you can see what sessions are available and when. We encourage all students to attend as many of these as possible and to liaise with their subject teachers regarding these. We have also been running English, maths and science revision during form times. This has been well received by the students and will continue after the mock examination period.

### External Tuition

In addition to this we will also be inviting specific students to attend external tutoring for identified students to help them catch-up lost learning from the first national lockdown. These will be decided by Heads of Faculty in partnership with Directors of Learning, to ensure those who need extra provision can access this. These sessions will be offered in addition to the intervention timetable already in existence. We will contact you directly by the end of November if you your child is highlighted as an individual who would benefit from further support. We will be using the mock examination data and information from teachers to identify these students.

### Wellbeing

We have also done some work to identify students that may need extra support in terms of accessing their learning. We have been running some counselling sessions for students with anxiety and are working as a pastoral team to support student wellbeing at this time. We understand the additional burden our year 11's are experiencing due to the pandemic, and will be working during form time to help students manage their worries.

### Revision Support

The students received a visit from Elevate in the first half term to talk to them and offer guidance in relation to study skills. Students have access to additional resources to help them with revision and planning their study. These can be accessed at <https://ukstudent.elevateeducation.com/> and the password is **rondo**.
